

## Notification regarding 2nd and 4th Saturday of every month as Holiday

1. Government of India, Ministry of Finance (Department of Financial Services) vide its Gazette notification F.No.4/1/7/2015-IR, dated 20<sup>th</sup> August 2015, has declared the second and fourth Saturday of every month as Public Holiday for Banks in India, whether or not such banks are included in the Second Schedule to the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934 (2 of 1934), with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2015, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 of the Negotiable Instruments Act 1881 (26 of 1881).

Further, it is also informed by IBA that while every second and fourth Saturday of every month will be public holiday for banks, **the other Saturdays of every month will be Full working days for banks.**

2. All Branches and offices are advised to take note of the same and to bring it to the notice of **the general public by prominently displaying the above information in the notice board of branches/offices.**
